Kuressaare airport (including Ruhnu aerodrome)
Kärdla airport
Pärnu airport (including Kihnu aerodrome)
Tallinn airport
Tartu airport

Valid from 01.01.2026

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1. Interpretation

- 1.1 For the purpose of this document AS Tallinna Lennujaam (address Tartu mnt 101, 10112 Tallinn, Estonia) shall mean the company that operates the following airports in Estonia:
 - 1.1.1 Tallinn airport
 - 1.1.2 Kuressaare airport, including Ruhnu aerodrome
 - 1.1.3 Kärdla airport
 - 1.1.4 Pärnu airport, including Kihnu aerodrome
 - 1.1.5 Tartu airport
- 1.2 This document excludes route air navigation and terminal navigation charges at Tallinn airport. These charges are applied by Estonian Air Navigation Services and shall be paid to Estonian Air Navigation Services.
- 1.3 This document excludes aircraft and passenger ground handling services or any other ground services. These charges are applied by ground handling service provider.
- 1.4 "Airport operator" means AS Tallinna Lennujaam as described in section 1.1.
- 1.5 "Airport User" means any person or legal entity that uses airport infrastructure and services for take-off, landing and aircraft parking and/or who carries passengers, mail or freight by air to or from the airport concerned.
- 1.6 "Based Airport user" means the Airport user which has concluded the aircraft base agreement with the Airport operator according to the general conditions of this document.
- 1.7 "Based aircraft" means the aircraft operated by Based Airport user for which the payment of airport charges are settled according to the valid aircraft base agreement.
- 1.8 "Charges" are charges for the use of airport for the services provided at the airport - landing charge, parking charge, passenger charge, take-off charge, security charge, terminal navigation charge and charge for a disabled passenger or passenger with reduced mobility.
- 1.9 "Contract" - the contract between the Airport User and the Airport operator that determines the conditions for the use of airport services, subject to the terms and conditions as set out in the Contract.
- 1.10 "Disabled passenger or passenger with reduced mobility" means any person whose mobility is limited for the purposes of using a means of transportation due to any physical (sensory or movement, permanent or temporary) or mental disability, due to age or to any other cause requiring special attention and adaptation to his/her needs of the services that are available to all passengers.
- 1.11 "Domestic flight" means a flight where the airports of both take-off and landing are within the Republic of Estonia and there is no intermediate landing outside this area.
- 1.12 "International flight" means all flights other than domestic flights.
- 1.13 "Maximum take-off weight" in relation to an aircraft means maximum allowed take-off weight as certified by the producer of the aircraft, approved by relevant civil aviation authority and registered in the aircraft manual (passport).
- 1.14 "Non-commercial flight" means any flight that does not involve the carriage of passengers, cargo or mail for hire or reward.
- 1.15 "Passenger" means any person carried on an aircraft with the exception of flight crew and cabin staff operating the aircraft.
- 1.16 "Scheduled flight" means one flight of the series of flights (to/from airport from/to the same destination), operated in clearly stated pattern and is sold via standard GDS or accessible public internet booking engines.

- 1.17 "Season" means one half year, which starts on last Sunday of March 00:00 local time and ends on last Saturday of October 24:00 local time in the same year or one-half year, which starts on last Sunday of October 00:00 local time and ends on last Saturday of March 24:00 local time next year.
- 1.18 "The time of landing" means the time recorded by the Airport operator as the time of touch down of an aircraft at the airport and 'the time of take-off' means the time recorded by the Airport operator as the time when the aircraft releases brakes on runway for starting take-off.
- 1.19 "Transfer passenger" is defined as a passenger having an onward journey on a connecting flight within 24 hours and passenger does not return to the same airport on the two-way journey.
- 1.20 "Transit passenger" means a passenger who arrives at the airport and continues its journey with the same aircraft (the flight number does not change).
- 1.21 If interpreting differences between original Estonian version of this document, then Estonian text shall prevail.

2. General conditions

- 2.1 These Conditions of Use regulate the commercial terms and conditions of the provision of the Airport's services in the territory of the airports and aerodromes under the administration of AS Tallinna Lennujaam. AS Tallinna Lennujaam Conditions of Use are based on legislation in force in the Republic of Estonia.
- 2.2 The terms and conditions are binding on all Airport Users who operate at one of the airports specified in paragraph 1.1 of the Conditions of Use irrespective of the nature of their operations (regular flight operators, charter flights, cargo flights, etc.).
- 2.3 The Airport User shall pay the airport charges for the as set out in this document. The Airport User shall pay for any services, assets and facilities provided to him or to the aircraft at the airport before the aircraft departs from the airport.
- 2.4 Airport User can pay for the services referred to in paragraph 2.3 either:
- in accordance with terms of payment agreed in writing in advance between the Airport Operator and the Airport User, or
 - in accordance with payment terms as stated in the invoice for charges rendered by the Airport Company to the Airport User.
- 2.5 The Airport company or the person appointed in written form by the Airport company has the right to refuse to provide airport services to the aircraft in case the applicable charges related to the last landing at the airport, parking or departure from the airport have not been paid or no warrant has been presented to guarantee the payment.
- 2.5.1 All costs related to calling in debts shall be paid by the Airport User.
- 2.6 The Airport User or its appointed handling agent shall provide the airport company with information relating to movements of its aircraft or aircraft handled by the agent at the airport within 24 hours of each of those movements, including information about the number of departing and arriving passengers, transit and transfer passengers and the volume of cargo and mail loaded/unloaded at the airport.
- 2.7 Airport company shall sign the basing contracts with Airport Users possessing a valid Air Operator Certificate (AOC) issued by Estonian Transport Administration. Airport company reserves the right to make exceptions to current conditions to the carriers possessing a valid Air Operator Certificate (AOC) issued in foreign countries and which perform commercial flights to/from the airport. These cases will be treated separately.
- 2.8 The Airport company reserves the right at any time upon giving notice to amend, vary or discharge any of the terms and conditions of use set out hereby.
- 2.9 Airport operator is liable for any direct damage arising from the provision of services by Airport operator where it can be proven that such damage was caused by the wilful misconduct or negligence of Airport operator. The burden of proof lies with the party making the claim. Airport operator is not liable for any consequential or indirect loss or damage, loss or damage of a

purely economic nature, or any loss or damage which could not reasonably have been foreseen by Airport operator. Airport operator must be notified of the occurrence of the damage (the basis for compensation for the damage) in writing within twenty (20) calendar days of the occurrence of the event. In no event can Airport operator be held liable for any accidents or damage caused by third parties (including, but not limited to, air navigation service providers, ground handling service providers or other Airport Users and persons staying at, using, providing or consuming services at airports and/or airfields and/or infrastructure managed by Airport operator).

Airport operator is exempted from the obligation to compensate for damages and from liability if the breach or non-performance of the obligations is due to specific grounds for exemption. Events that are unusual and affect operations, which could not have been foreseen by Airport operator or which are beyond the control and influence of Airport operator, or the effects of which could not reasonably have been avoided or overcome, are deemed to be sufficient reasons for exemption from liability (force majeure). Examples of such events may include war, unrest, foreign currency restrictions, government regulations and orders, export bans, natural disasters, severe weather conditions, interruption of traffic, data communications or power distribution, shortage of transportation, general shortage of materials, power supply restrictions, labour dispute, fire or any other unusual event with the same effect beyond the control of Airport operator, including errors or delays in subcontractor deliveries for the above reasons. In the event of a delay in the fulfilment of the commitments of Airport operator for any of the above reasons, the deadline for the fulfilment of the commitments shall be extended by such period as is deemed reasonable having regard to all the circumstances of the case.

2.10 All flights are subject to value added tax according to Value-Added Tax Act of the Republic of Estonia

3. Applying for the use of the airports

- 3.1 Airport User planning to operate regular flights must notify Airport by submitting flight schedules to airport schedule facilitating company at least 60 office days before commencement of scheduled flights to and from the airport. Schedule change notifications should be submitted in similar manner promptly after enforcing relevant changes. Contacts: see Appendix 1.
- 3.2 The Airport user must settle the details of payment for scheduled flights to and from the airport in writing at least 5 office days before starting the service
- 3.3 When applying for the permission to commence a service under the terms of this Conditions of Use, authorised documents attesting registration number, maximum take-off weight and seating capacity of Airport Users aircraft (for this service) must be provided.

4. Payments

- 4.1 Payments for the airport services must be made before the flight departure unless otherwise agreed. Airport Users operating non-scheduled flights to Tallinn airport must pay for the airport services to company providing apron handling service or to the airport representative in other airports mentioned in this document. Contacts: see Appendix 1.
- 4.2 Discounts shall only be applied to Airport Users that have no overdue payments. Applications to qualify for the discount must be presented directly to the airport where the flights shall be operated. Contacts: see Appendix 1.
- 4.3 Airport invoices must be paid by the date as indicated on the invoice.
- 4.4 In case of delay with payments the Airport operator is allowed to require an interest of 0,07% of unpaid sum a day, if there is no other agreement, and refuse to provide services to this client until the payment of debts.
- 4.5 The Airport Operator has the right to demand advance payment from the Airport Users, inter alia, in situations where the Airport User has had delays or payment difficulties in the payment of earlier invoices, the operations of the Airport User are seasonal or irregular, or if this is necessary to protect the interests of the Airport Operator.

5. Exemptions from the airport charges

- 5.1 Exemption from payment for airport services shall be granted in accordance with § 59 of the Aviation Act.
- 5.2 In order to qualify for the exemption from the charges, the relevant information which is the basis for the exemption must be indicated in the flight plan.
- 5.3 The government agency that governs the areas of activities related to flights exempt from charges for use of airport services notifies the service provider in advance of the planned flights exempt from service charges and pays the service provider for the flights exempt from the charges. The failure to perform the notification obligation does not exempt from the obligation to pay for the service.

6. Enquiries

- 6.1 All enquiries regarding this document should be addressed in writing to the Airport operator or directly to the respective airport. Contacts: see Appendix 1.

7. Tallinn airport charges

7.1 Landing charge

- 7.1.1 Landing charge is charged for aircraft landing at the airport for every 1000 kgs of maximum take-off weight or a part thereof* according to the following principle:

	Charge per ton/EUR
Landing charge	7,50

* Example – if aircraft weighs 750 kg, then its weight is rounded up to 1000 kg; if aircraft weighs 2025 kg then its weight is rounded up to 3000 kg

7.2 Passenger charge

- 7.2.1 Passenger charge is collected per every departing passenger as follows:

Local passenger	10,50 EUR
Transfer passenger	2,94 EUR

- 7.2.2 Airport User pays passenger charge to Airport on behalf of passengers.

7.2.3 Passenger charges are not applied to:

- 7.2.3.1 a child under two years of age if the child is travelling without a separate ticket.
- 7.2.3.2 a person who is appointed to check the aircraft or the equipment or crew thereof, or flies to perform such;
- 7.2.3.3 crew members of an aircraft in connection with their duties.
- 7.2.3.4 participants in search, rescue or training flights.
- 7.2.3.5 to transit passengers
- 7.2.3.6 to passengers on the ambulance flights.

7.3 Charge for a disabled passenger or passenger with reduced mobility

- 7.3.1 Charge for a disabled passenger or passenger with reduced mobility is collected per every departing passenger.

Charge for a disabled passenger or passenger with reduced mobility	0,48 EUR
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- 7.3.2 100% discount from the charge for a disabled passenger or passenger with reduced mobility will be applied to:

- 7.3.2.1 participants in search, rescue, or training flights
- 7.3.2.2 transit passengers
- 7.3.2.3 a person who is appointed to check the aircraft or the equipment or crew thereof, or flies to perform such.
- 7.3.2.4 crew members of an aircraft in connection with their duties.
- 7.3.2.5 to passengers on the ambulance flights.

7.2.3.6 to a child under two years of age. (as of 01.02.2026)

7.3.3 This service is provided in accordance with the conditions as set out in Regulation (EC) No 1107/2006 of the European Parliament and Airport operator's procedure QRT-E-K-02 „Handling of the disabled passengers and passengers with reduced mobility at Tallinn airport“.

7.4 Security charge

7.4.1 Security charge is collected per every departing passenger.

Security charge per passenger	2,87 EUR
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7.4.2 Airport User pays security charge to Airport on behalf of passenger.

7.4.3 Security charge is not applied to a child under two years of age. (as of 01.02.2026)

7.5 Parking charge

7.5.1 Aircraft parking period shall start when the aircraft reaches the parking position (onblock time) and shall end when the aircraft leaves the parking position (off-block time).

7.5.2 Parking charge is not collected if aircraft is parked on the apron:

7.5.2.1 less than 6 hours - all-cargo aircraft (based on aircraft arrival)

7.5.2.2 less than 3 hours - all other aircraft

7.5.3 If parking longer than established in point 7.5.2. the parking charge is being taken for the parking of the aircraft in any area of the territory of the airport, calculated per 1000 kg of the aircraft maximum take-off weight (rounded up) per every started 24-hour period as following:

	Parking charge unit rate	Minimum parking charge per 24 hours
Non-based aircraft	1,53 EUR	25 EUR
Based aircraft	0,64 EUR	25 EUR

7.5.4 Parking charge discount

25% discount from parking charge is applicable to scheduled passenger flights operated by aircraft not based in Tallinn airport.

7.6 Route Incentive Scheme

8. Kuressaare airport and Ruhnu aerodrome charges

8.1 Landing charge

8.1.1 Landing charge is charged for aircraft landing operations at the airport for every 1000 kgs of maximum take-off weight (MTOW) or a part thereof* according to the following principle:

Aerodrome	Charge per ton/MTOW
Kuressaare	7,50 EUR
Ruhnu	7,50 EUR

* Example – if aircraft weighs 750 kg then its weight is rounded up to 1000 kg; if aircraft weighs 2025 kg then its weight is rounded up to 3000 kg

8.2 Passenger charge

8.2.1 Passenger charge is collected per every departing passenger as follows:

	Per departing passenger
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Kuressaare	10,50 EUR
Ruhnu	10,50 EUR

8.2.2 Airport User pays passenger charge to Airport on behalf of passenger.

8.2.3 Passenger charges are not applied to:

8.2.3.1 a child under two years of age if the child is travelling without a separate ticket.

8.2.3.2 a person who is appointed to check the aircraft or the equipment or crew thereof, or flies to perform such;

8.2.3.3 crew members of an aircraft in connection with their duties.

8.2.3.4 participants in search, rescue or training flights.

8.2.3.5 to passengers on the ambulance flights.

8.3 Security charge

8.3.1 Security charge is collected per every departing passenger.

Security charge per passenger	2,87 EUR
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8.3.2 Airport User pays security charge to Airport on behalf of passenger.

8.3.3 Security charge is not applied to a child under two years of age.

8.4 Parking charge

8.4.1 Aircraft parking period shall start when the aircraft reaches the parking position (onblock time) and shall end when the aircraft leaves the parking position (off-block time).

8.4.2 Parking is free of charge if aircraft is parked on the airport territory:

8.4.2.1 up to 6 hours – all-cargo aircraft (based on aircraft arrival)

8.4.2.2 up to 3 hours – all other aircraft

8.4.3 If parking longer than established in point 8.4.2. the parking charge is collected for the parking of the aircraft in any area of airport territory, calculated per 1000 kg of the aircraft maximum take-off weight (rounded up) per every started 24-hour period as following:

Aerodrome	Non-based aircraft	Based aircraft	Minimum parking charge for 24-hour period
Kuressaare	1,28 EUR	0,64 EUR	15 EUR
Ruhnu	0,64 EUR		15 EUR

8.5 Take-off charge

8.5.1 Take-off charge is applied at Kuressaare airport for take-offs outside official airport operating hours and provided that air traffic services have been previously requested.

Take-off charge is applied also in case if aircraft takes off during official operating hours, but airport will start to provide flight information service outside the official operating hours.

8.5.2 Take-off charge is applied as follows:

International flight 89,48 EUR

Domestic flight 89,48 EUR

8.6 Terminal Navigation charge

9.6.1 A terminal navigation charge is a charge to be paid for a flight in a terminal control area, control zone or flight information zone of an airport and using aerodrome flight information service.

8.6.2 Terminal Navigation charge is applied for landings at Kuressaare airport with aircraft with MTOW more than 500 kg. The charge is determined according to the following formula:

$$T = p \times w$$

whereas T is the terminal navigation charge with two decimals,

p is the unit price as follows

international flight	p = 139,91 EUR
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domestic flight	p = 139,91s EUR
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and w is the aircraft MTOW ($w = \sqrt{\text{MTOW} : 50}$, where MTOW is in tons with three decimals).

- 8.6.3 Terminal navigation charge will not be paid for aircraft departing from an airport.
- 8.6.4 The terminal navigation charge is not collected for flights of aircraft flying in terminal control area of an airport without landing provided that the route air navigation charge is paid.
- 8.6.5 Aircraft conducting low approaches and touch-and-go landings shall pay a sum of the charges as set out in p.8.6.2 equal to one landing.

8.7 Discounts

8.7.1 Discount for training flights

- 8.7.1.1 30% discount from landing charge and 50% terminal navigation charge is applied to all aircraft performing training flights.
- 8.7.1.2 For aircraft conducting low approaches and touch-and-go landings the total of the landing charge and terminal navigation charge is equal to one landing.
- 8.7.1.3 In case of touch-and-go landings landing charge and terminal navigation charge is applied after each fifth touch-and-go.
- 8.7.1.4 In case of conducting low approaches, terminal navigation charge is applied after each fifth low approach.
- 8.7.1.5 In case of performing training flights outside airport official operating hours and provided that flight information service has been previously requested 50% discount of the published landing surcharge and take-off charge will be applied.

8.7.2 Discount for aircraft with MTOW up to 2700 (incl) kg.

100% discount from passenger charge is applied to aircraft with MTOW up to 2700(incl) kg.

9. Kärdla airport charges

9.1 Landing charge

- 9.1.1 Landing charge is charged for aircraft landing operations at the airport for every 1000 kgs of maximum take-off weight (MTOW) or a part thereof* according to the following principle:

	per ton
Landing charge	7,50 EUR

* Example – if aircraft weighs 750 kg then its weight is rounded up to 1000 kg; if aircraft weighs 2025 kg then its weight is rounded up to 3000 kg

9.2 Passenger charge

- 9.2.1 Passenger charge is collected per every departing passenger as follows:

Passenger charge per departing passenger	10,50 EUR
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- 9.2.2 Airport User pays passenger charge to Airport on behalf of passenger.

9.2.3 Passenger charges are not applied to:

- 9.2.3.1 a child under two years of age if the child is travelling without a separate ticket.
- 9.2.3.2 a person who is appointed to check the aircraft or the equipment or crew thereof, or flies to perform such;
- 9.2.3.3 crew members of an aircraft in connection with their duties.
- 9.2.3.4 participants in search, rescue or training flights.
- 9.2.3.5 to passengers on the ambulance flights.

9.3 Security charge

- 9.3.1 Security charge is collected per every departing passenger.

Security charge per passenger	2,87 EUR
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- 9.3.2 Airport User pays security charge to Airport on behalf of passenger

- 9.3.3 Security charge is not collected from a child under two years of age.

9.4 Parking charge

9.4.1 Aircraft parking period shall start when the aircraft reaches the parking position (on-block time) and shall end when the aircraft leaves the parking position (off-block time).

9.4.2 Parking is free of charge if aircraft is parked on the airport territory

9.4.2.1 up to 6 hours – all-cargo aircraft (based on aircraft arrival)

9.4.2.2 up to 3 hours – all other aircraft

9.4.3 If parking longer than established in point 9.4.2. the parking charge is being taken for the parking of the aircraft in any area of the territory of the airport, calculated per 1000 kg of the aircraft maximum take-off weight (rounded up) per every started 24-hour period as following:

	Parking charge	Minimum parking charge per 24 hours
Non-based aircraft	1,28 EUR	15 EUR
Based aircraft	0,64 EUR	15 EUR

9.5 Take-off charge

9.5.1 Take-off charge is applied at Kärdla airport for take-offs outside official airport operating hours and provided that aerodrome flight information service has been previously requested. Take-off charge is applied also in case if aircraft takes off during official operating hours, but airport will start to provide aerodrome flight information service outside the official operating hours.

9.5.2 Take-off charge is applied as follows:

International flight 89,48 EUR

Domestic flight 89,48 EUR

9.6 Terminal navigation charge

9.6.1 Terminal navigation charge is a charge to be paid for a flight in a terminal control area, control zone or flight information zone of an airport and using aerodrome flight information service.

9.6.2 Terminal Navigation charge is applied for landings at Kärdla airport with aircraft with MTOW more than 500 kg. The charge is determined according to the following formula:

$$T = p \times w$$

whereas T is the terminal navigation charge with two decimals,

p is the unit price as follows:

International flight	p = 139,91 EUR
Domestic flight	p = 139,91 EUR

and w is the aircraft MTOW ($w = \sqrt{\text{MTOW} : 50}$, where MTOW is in tons with three decimals).

9.6.3 Terminal navigation charge will not be paid for aircraft departing from an airport.

9.6.4 The terminal navigation charge is not collected for flights of aircraft flying in terminal control area of an airport without landing provided that the route air navigation charge is paid.

9.6.5 Aircraft conducting low approaches and touch-and-go landings shall pay a sum of the charges as set out in p.9.6.2 equal to one landing.

9.7 Discounts

9.7.1 Discount for training flights

9.7.1.1 30% discount from landing charge and 50% terminal navigation charge is applied to all aircraft performing training flights.

- 9.7.1.2 For aircraft conducting low approaches and touch-and-go landings the total of the landing charge and terminal navigation charge is equal to one landing.
- 9.7.1.3 In case of touch-and-go landings landing charge and terminal navigation charge is applied after each fifth touch-and-go.
- 9.7.1.4 In case of conducting low approaches, terminal navigation charge is applied after each fifth low approach.
- 9.7.1.5 In case of performing training flights outside airport official operating hours and provided that flight information service has been previously requested 50% discount of the published landing surcharge and take-off charge will be applied.

9.7.2 Discount for aircraft with MTOW up to 2700(incl) kg.

100% discount from passenger charge is applied to aircraft with MTOW up to 2700(incl) kg.

10. Pärnu airport and Kihnu aerodrome charges

10.1 Landing charge

10.1.1 Landing charge is charged for aircraft landing operations at the airport for every 1000 kgs of maximum take-off weight (MTOW) or a part thereof* according to the following principle:

Aerodrome	Charge per ton
Pärnu	7,50 EUR
Kihnu	7,50 EUR

* Example – if aircraft weighs 750 kg then its weight is rounded up to 1000 kg; if aircraft weighs 2025 kg then its weight is rounded up to 3000 kg

10.2 Passenger charge

10.2.1 Passenger charge is charged for every departing passenger as follows:

Aerodrome	Per departing passenger
Pärnu	10,50 EUR
Kihnu	10,50 EUR

10.2.3 Passenger charges are not applied to:

- 10.2.3.1 a child under two years of age if the child is travelling without a separate ticket.
- 10.2.3.2 a person who is appointed to check the aircraft or the equipment or crew thereof, or flies to perform such;
- 10.2.3.3 crew members of an aircraft in connection with their duties.
- 10.2.3.4 participants in search, rescue or training flights.
- 10.2.3.5 to passengers on the ambulance flights.

10.3 Parking charge

10.3.1 Aircraft parking period will begin when the aircraft reaches the parking position (on-block time) and ends when the aircraft leaves the parking position (off-block time).

10.3.2 During the parking period no parking charge is charged from aircraft parking

- 10.3.2.1 less than 6 hours – all-cargo aircraft (based on aircraft arrival)
- 10.3.2.2 less than 3 hours - all other aircraft

10.3.3 If parking longer than established in point 10.3.2. the parking charge is being taken for the parking of the aircraft in any area of the territory of the airport, calculated per 1000 kg of the aircraft maximum take-off weight (rounded up) per every started 24-hour period as following:

Aerodrome	Non-based aircraft	Based aircraft	Minimum parking charge per 24-hours or part thereof
Pärnu	1,28 EUR	0,64 EUR	15 EUR
Kihnu	0,64 EUR		15 EUR

10.4 Security charge

10.4.1 Security charge is collected per every departing passenger.

Security charge per passenger	2,87 EUR
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- 10.4.2 Airport User pays security charge to Airport on behalf of passenger
10.4.3 Security charge is not collected from a child under two years of age.

10.5 Take-off charge

- 10.5.1 Take-off charge is applied at Pärnu airport for take-offs outside official airport operating hours and provided that flight information service has been previously requested.

Take-off charge is applied also in case if aircraft takes off during official operating hours, but airport will start to provide flight information service outside the official operating hours.

- 10.5.2 Take-off charge is applied as follows:

International flight	89,48 EUR
Domestic flight	89,48 EUR

10.6 Terminal navigation charge

- 10.6.1 Terminal navigation charge is a charge to be paid for a flight in a terminal control area, control zone or flight information zone of an airport and using aerodrome flight information service.

- 10.6.2 Terminal navigation charge is applied for landings at Pärnu airport with aircraft with MTOW more than 500 kg. The charge is determined according to the following formula:

$$T = p \times w$$

whereas T is the terminal navigation charge with two decimals,
p is the unit price as follows:

International flight	p =139,91 EUR
Domestic flight	p =139,91 EUR

and w is the aircraft MTOW ($w = \sqrt{\text{MTOW} : 50}$, where MTOW is in tons with three decimals).

- 10.6.3 Terminal navigation charge will not be paid for aircraft departing from an airport.
10.6.4 The terminal navigation charge is not collected for flights of aircraft flying in terminal control area of an airport without landing provided that the route air navigation charge is paid.
10.6.5 Aircraft conducting low approaches and touch-and-go landings shall pay a sum of the charges as set out in p.10.6.2 equal to one landing.

10.7 Discounts

10.7.1 Discount for training flights

- 10.7.1.1. 30% discount from landing charge and 50% terminal navigation charge is applied to all aircraft performing training flights.
10.7.1.2 For aircraft conducting low approaches and touch-and-go landings the total of the landing charge and terminal navigation charge is equal to one landing.
10.7.1.3 In case of touch-and-go landings landing charge and terminal navigation charge is applied after each fifth touch-and-go. In case of conducting low approaches terminal navigation charge is applied after each fifth low approach.
10.7.1.4 In case of performing training flights outside airport official operating hours and provided that flight information service has been previously requested 50% discount of the published landing surcharge and take-off charge will be applied.

10.7.2 Discount for aircraft with MTOW up to 2700(incl) kg.

100% discount from passenger charge is applied to aircraft with MTOW up to 2700(incl) kg.

11. Tartu airport charges

11.1 Landing charge

11.1.1 Landing charge is charged for aircraft landing operations at the airport for every 1000 kgs of maximum take-off weight (MTOW) or a part thereof* according to the following principle:

Landing charge per ton/MTOW	7,50 EUR
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* Example – if aircraft weighs 750 kg then its weight is rounded up to 1000 kg; if aircraft weighs 2025 kg then its weight is rounded up to 3000 kg.

11.2 Passenger charge

11.2.1 Passenger charge is charged for every departing passenger as follows

Passenger charge per departing passenger	10,50 EUR
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11.2.2 Airport User pays passenger charge to the airport on behalf of passengers.

11.2.3 Passenger charges are not applied to:

11.2.3.1 a child under two years of age if the child is travelling without a separate ticket.

11.2.3.2 a person who is appointed to check the aircraft or the equipment or crew thereof, or flies to perform such;

11.2.3.3 crew members of an aircraft in connection with their duties.

11.2.3.4 participants in search, rescue or training flights.

11.2.3.5 to passengers on the ambulance flights.

11.3 Parking charge

11.3.1 Aircraft parking period shall start when the aircraft reaches the parking position (on-block time) and shall end when the aircraft leaves the parking position (off-block time).

11.3.2 Parking is free of charge if aircraft is parked on airport territory:

11.3.2.1 up to 6 hours – all-cargo aircraft (based on aircraft arrival)

11.3.2.2 up to 3 hours – all other aircraft

11.3.3 If parking longer than established in point 11.3.2. the parking charge is being taken for the parking of the aircraft in any area of the territory of the airport, calculated per 1000 kg of the aircraft maximum take-off weight (rounded up) per every started 24-hour period as following:

	Parking charge	Minimum parking charge per 24 hours
Non-based aircraft	1,28 EUR	15 EUR
Based aircraft	0,64 EUR	15 EUR

11.4 Security charge

11.4.1 Security charge is collected per every departing passenger.

Security charge per passenger	2,87 EUR
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11.4.2 Airport User pays security charge to Airport on behalf of passenger.

11.4.3 Security charge is not applied to a child under two years of age.

11.5 Take-off charge

11.5.1 Take-off charge is applied at Tartu airport for take-offs outside official airport operating hours and provided that air traffic services have been previously requested.

Take-off charge is applied also in case if aircraft takes off during official operating hours, but airport will start to provide aerodrome flight information service outside the official operating hours.

11.5.2 Take-off charge is applied as follows:

International flight	89,48 EUR
Domestic flight	89,48 EUR

11.6 Terminal navigation charge

11.6.1 Terminal navigation charge is a charge to be paid for a flight in a terminal control area, control zone or flight information zone of an airport and using aerodrome flight information service.

11.6.2 Terminal navigation charge is applied for landings at Tartu airport which is based on the maximum take-off weight of the aircraft and the charge is determined in accordance with the following formula:

$$T = p \times w$$

whereas T is the terminal navigation charge with two decimals,
p is the unit price as follows:

International flight	p = 139,91 EUR*
Domestic flight	p = 139,91 EUR*

and w is the aircraft MTOW $w = (\text{MTOW}: 50)^{0.7}$, where MTOW is in tons with three decimals).

11.6.3 Discount of 50% is applied to the terminal navigation charges for school flight (flight performed by student as a trainee of pilot within the frames of a training programme) performed by terminal control area and control zone under the following circumstances:

11.6.3.1 School flight and/or appropriate training programme has been pre-coordinated with the Flight Data Office (FDO) of Estonian Air Navigation Services in written form:

11.6.3.2 The filled flight plan contains the following remark: "RMK/SCHOOLFLIGHT".

11.6.4 Terminal navigation charge will not be paid for aircraft departing from an airport.

11.6.5 The terminal navigation charge is not collected for flights of aircraft flying in terminal control area of an airport without landing provided that the route air navigation charge is paid.

11.6.6 Aircraft conducting low approaches and touch-and-go landings shall pay a sum of the charges as set out in p.11.6.2 equal to one landing.

* Terminal navigation service is provided by Estonian Air Navigation Services. Terminal navigation charges, conditions and discounts are listed herein have informative purposes.

11.7 Discounts

11.7.1 Discount for aircraft with MTOW up to 2 700(incl.) kg.

100% discount from passenger charge is applied to aircraft with MTOW up to 2700(incl.) kg.

11.7.2 Discount for school and training flights

30% discount from landing charge is applied to all aircraft performing school and training flights.

In case of performing school or training flights outside airport official operating hours 50% discount of the published landing surcharge and take-off charge will be applied.

In case touch and go landings are carried out at the airport, the landing charge is applied as a one-time charge after the last landing of the aircraft.

12. Opening the airport outside official operating hours

12.1 For opening the airport outside official operating hours, an opening charge will be applied as follows:

Airport	Tartu	Kuressaare	Kärdla	Pärnu	Ruhnu
Summer (01.04-30.09)	800	800	800	800	800
Winter (01.10-31.03)	1500	1500	1500	1500	1500

12.2 During the summer period, an opening charge is applied for every 2 hours the airport is open, and during the winter period, an opening charge is applied for every 3 hours the airport is open.

12.3 The airport reserves the right to refuse opening outside its official operating hours.

12.4 Additional charges for other services will be applied according to the valid price list.

13. Weather forecast and warning service

13.1 The charge for ordering the weather forecast and warning service is as follows
